Centre gives nod for free trade warehousing zone in GIFT SEZ

Ahmedabad: The Union ministry of commerce and industry has given its green signal for setting up a free trade warehousing zone (FTWZ) at the special economic zone (SEZ) in Gujarat International Finance-Tec City (GIFT) near Gandhinagar. FTWZ is a special category of SEZ focusing on warehousing and trading.

The FTWZ will provide storage and business-to-business display area for precious commodities such as bullion and diamond and no basic custom duty is levied on goods stored in the zone.

Confirming the development, Upendra Vasishth, zonal development commissioner, Gujarat (SEZ and EOUs) stated that one unit has also been granted approval for operating gold vault from the

FTWZ, which will be housed in the building being developed by ATS-Savvy group.

The establishment of FTWZ in the state is expected to boost gold trade as India is one of the largest importers of gold in the world and Gujarat accounts for large chunk of gold imported in the country.

d imported in the country. According to bullion traders, gold purchased from London or China through notified agencies takes around 30-45 days to reach in the state. However, the bullion trader can procure gold from vaulting unit in FTWZ, where gold is already imported and stored, and can save time and freight cost as well. Apart from bullion items,

Apart from bullion items, pharma and fashion industry products as well as medical instrumentations, the FTWZ will also be able to conduct international art auctions, said a senior official at GIFT IFSC.

"This would be one-of-itskind FTWZ in the country where the SEZ will not only house high value goods but will also be used for international art auction," said Dipesh Shah, head, GIFT IFSC.

Mr. Sunil Joshi (President, Business Operations, GIFT City) represented GIFT City in the inaugural session of the summit.






